*Warnings:* For external use only. If swallowed, contact a doctor or poison control center immediately. Keep out of the reach of children. Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if the child is under 6 years of age.

### DO NOT USE:

- · If the solution changes color or gets cloudy
- With contact lenses
- · If any open wounds exist in or near the eye or an object is embedded

## WHEN USING THIS PRODUCT:

- · Remove contact lenses before using
- · Do not re-use once opened

## STOP USE AND ASK A DOCTOR IF:

- · You experience eye irritation, pain, or continued redness
- You have changes in vision
- Conditions persist or worsen

## Directions:

Tamper evident packaging, do not use if seal around the top is opened, broken or missing. Do not use past the expiration date.

Adults and children over 6:

Open top, flush affected area as needed, controlling rate of flow by pressure on the bottle. Do not touch tip of bottle to any surface.

Children under 6:

Consult a doctor or pharmacist
